MANAGERS UPDATE

- T. Silverthorn, Manager, Tourism provided the Commission with an update of recent activity, including the following:
 - Instead of 8:00 a.m., future Commission meetings will be held at 3:30 p.m.
 - Gemma Patterson, Administrative Assistant was introduced to the Commission.
 - A Memorandum of Understanding was recently signed with the Regional District of North Okanagan for cost sharing for the Greater Vernon online interactive trails map. Tourism Vernon will now be hosting and updating this map.
